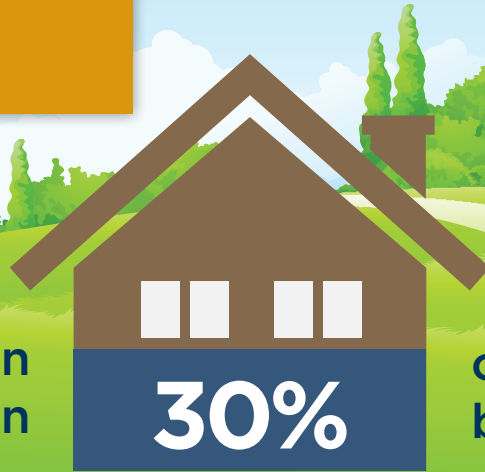


# 2017 Housing Need in Burke County

**20%** of homeowners

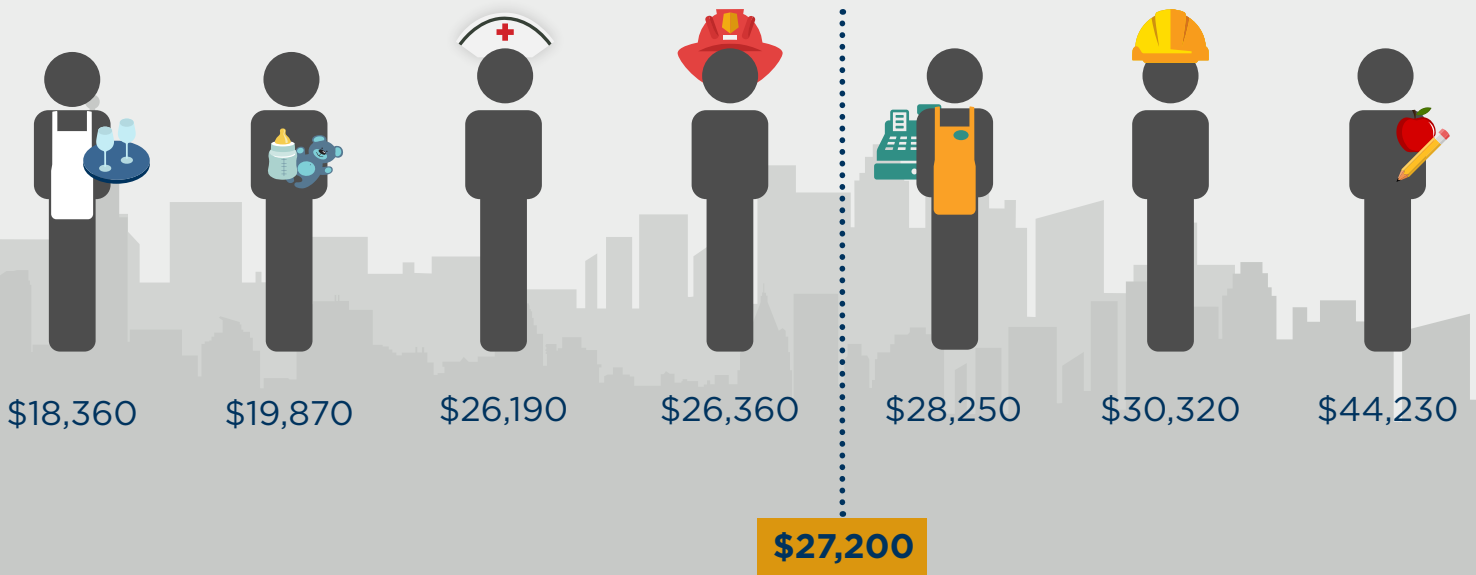


**(4,972 households)**

In order to afford a modest two-bedroom apartment at

**\$680/month**

A family needs to earn:

**\$27,200 / year**

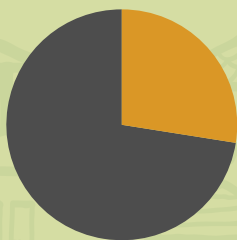


The average renter can only afford a rent of:

## Eviction Filings

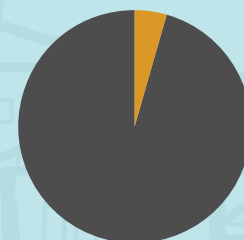
In 2016, **568** families faced an eviction
