Housing is affordable when  
it comprises no more than

**30%**

of the family's  
budget\*

\*including utilities

In Jackson County, **32%**



**(5,100 households)** are cost-burdened.

**48%** of renters



**(2,476 households)**

**24%** of homeowners



**(2,624 households)**

have difficulty affording their homes.

**\$642/month**

A family needs to earn:

**\$25,680 / year**

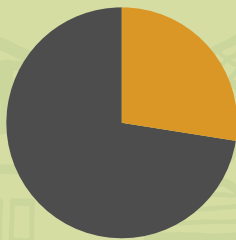


The average renter can only afford a rent of:

In 2016, **206** families faced an eviction

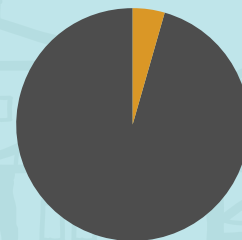


**8.3%**
