Average Annual Salaries



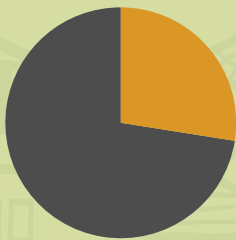
In order to afford a modest two-bedroom apartment at **\$710/month**

In 2016, **594** families faced an eviction

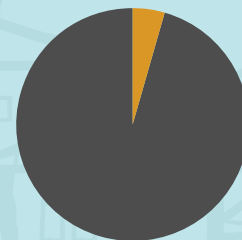
