\$25,680 / year

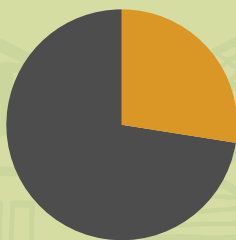


The average renter can only afford a rent of:

In 2016, **219** families faced an eviction

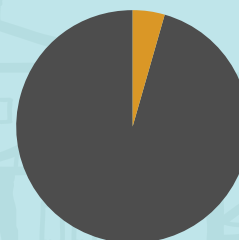


19.2%
