


The 2019 Housing Need in Camden County

Housing is affordable when it comprises no more than **30% of the family's budget.** Families that spend more than this on housing are **cost-burdened.**

The average family spends:

\$252 each month on energy costs, or...

4.4% of their monthly income

Renters earning less than 50% AMI spend



\$179 average monthly amount spent on energy, or...

8.3% of household income
