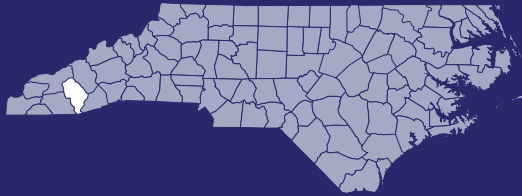
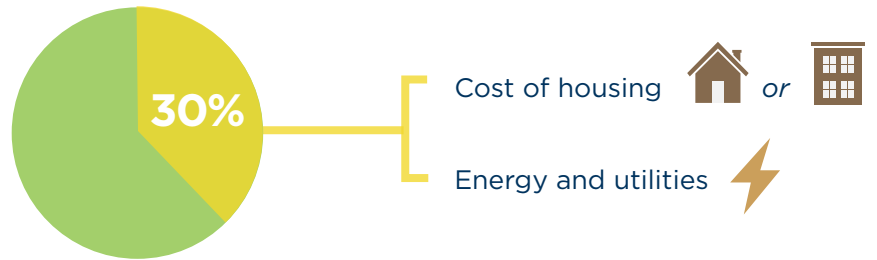


# The 2019 Housing Need in Jackson County

Housing is affordable when it comprises no more than **30% of the family's budget**. Families that spend more than this on housing are **cost-burdened**.



**30%** of Jackson County are **cost-burdened**  
4,773 households

**Renters** who have difficulty affording their homes:



**52%**

2,528 households

**Homeowners** who have difficulty affording their homes:



**21%**

2,245 households

## Rental Market in Jackson County



To afford a modest two-bedroom apartment at:

**\$683/month**



A family needs to earn:

**\$27,320/year**



But the average renter can only afford a rent of:

**\$436/month**

## North Carolina Energy Burden

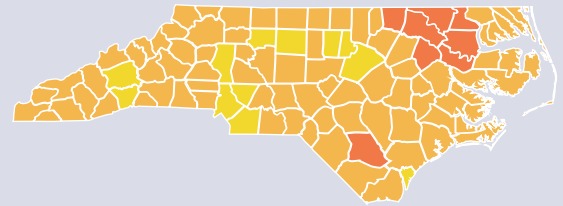
According to the US Department of Health and Human Services, paying **more than 6%** of a household's budget on energy is unaffordable.

## Jackson County Energy Burden



The average family spends:

**\$177** each month on energy costs, or...

**4.1%** of their monthly income

### Renters earning less than 50% AMI spend



**\$132** average monthly amount spent on energy, or...

**10.1%** of household income

### Homeowners earning less than 50% AMI spend



**\$165** average monthly amount spent on energy, or...

**12%** of household income

When housing costs become too much, a family can lose their home. This takes an incredible toll not only on a family, but also on the entire community.



**261** families in Jackson County faced an eviction filing this year...

**10.3%** of all cost-burdened renters.



**234** families in Jackson County faced a foreclosure this year...

**10.4%** of all cost-burdened homeowners.
