


# The 2019 Housing Need in Nash County


### **North Carolina Energy Burden**

## **Nash County Energy Burden**



The average family spends:

**\$278** each month on energy costs, or...

**5.9%** of their monthly income

#### Renters earning less than 50% AMI spend
