


The 2019 Housing Need in Stokes County

Housing is affordable when it comprises no more than **30% of the family's budget.** Families that spend more than this on housing are **cost-burdened.**


Area Median Income (AMI) for Stokes County

North Carolina Energy Burden

According to the US Department of Health and Human Services, paying more than 6% of a household's budget on energy is unaffordable.

Stokes County Energy Burden



The average family spends:

\$189 each month on energy costs, or...

4.5% of their monthly income

Renters earning less than 50% AMI spend



\$132 average monthly amount spent on energy, or...

9.3% of household income
