**\$31,520 / year**

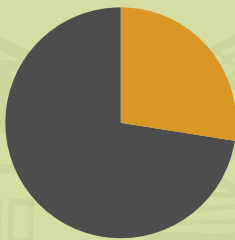


The average renter can only afford a rent of:

In 2016, **74** families faced an eviction

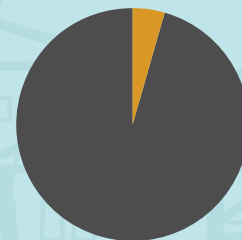


**12.2%**
