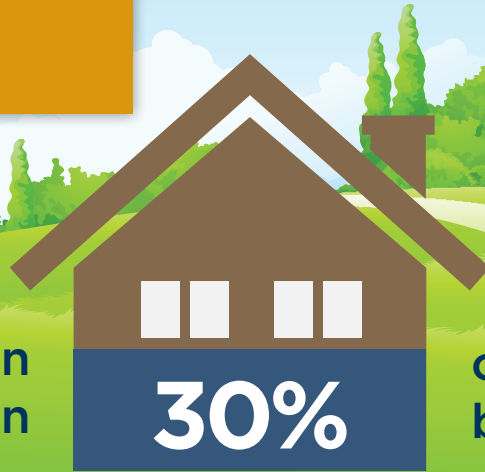


# 2017 Housing Need in Warren County

**31%** of homeowners

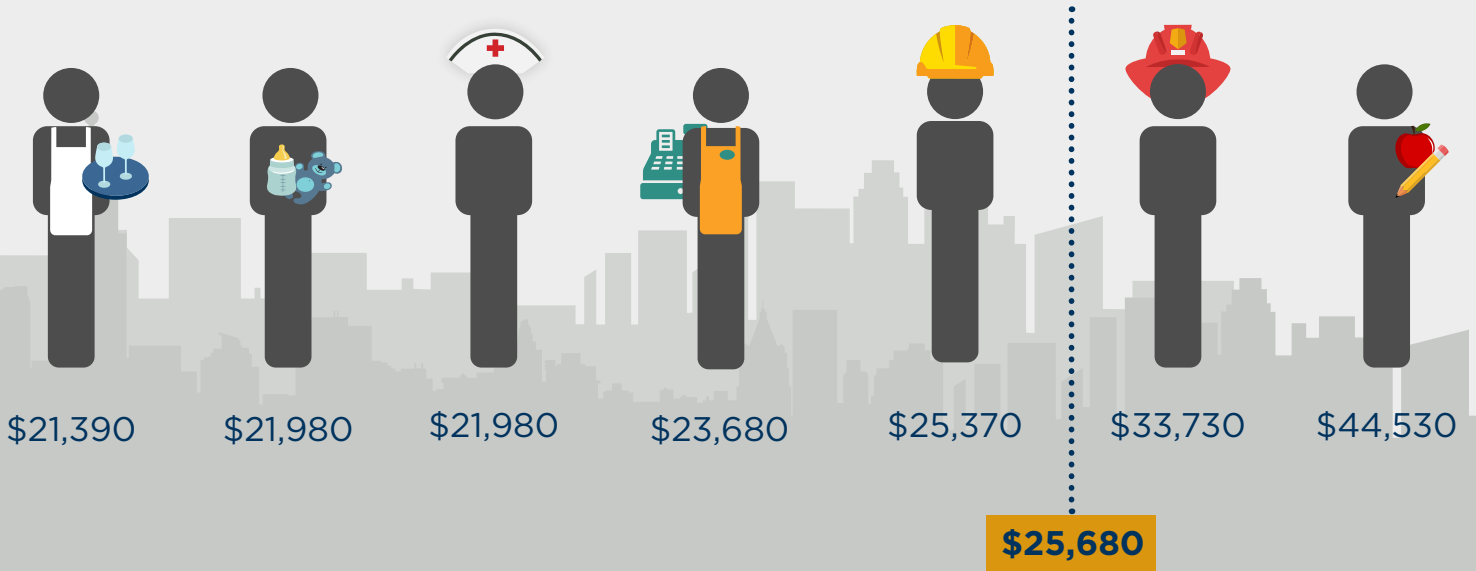


**(1,718 households)**

A family needs to earn:

**\$25,680 / year**

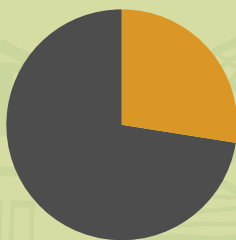


The average renter can only afford a rent of:

In 2016, **208** families faced an eviction

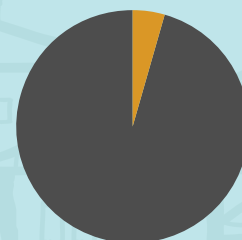


**26.0%**
